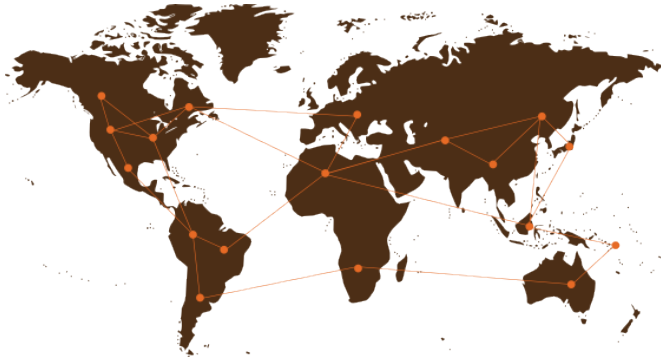

The Internet

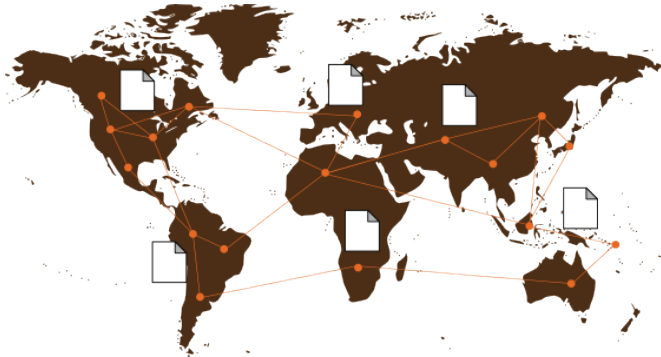
Largest network of computing devices in the world

The World Wide Web

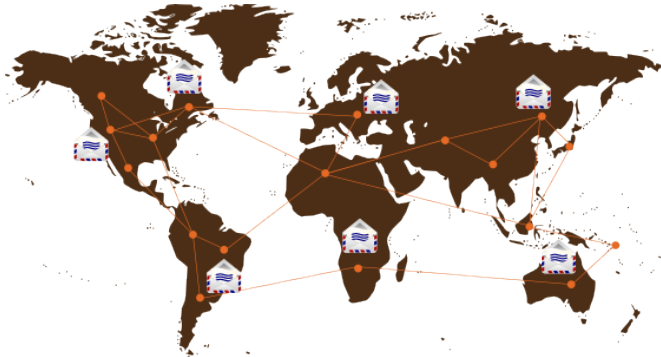
The most widely used service on the Internet

Electronic Mail

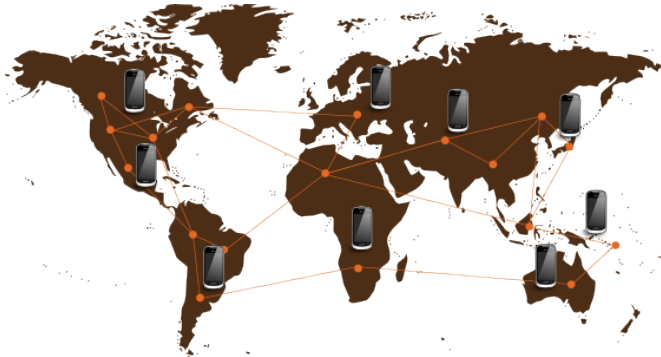
Just like sending mail but very fast anywhere in the world

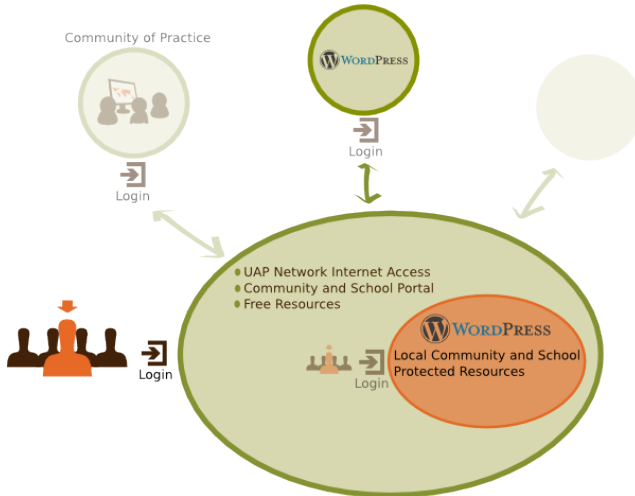



This wiki is based on the book *Reef and Rainforest: An Environmental Encyclopedia of Marovo Lagoon, Solomon Islands* Kitadi oro vivineidi na ingitonga pa idere oro pa goans pa Marovo an illustrated encyclopedia of the coral reef and rainforest environments of the Marovo Lagoon in the New Georgia Group of Solomon Islands, in the Melanesian southwest Pacific. Its title in the Marovo language literally means "The Names and Stories of the Things in the Sea and Forest of Marovo".

The following is documentation of local perspectives on the mass death of marine life in June 2011. The event resulted in the deaths of thousands of fish and other marine life in the estimated 42 square km affected area in the Marovo Lagoon, a major concern for the rural villages who depend on the lagoon to live.
